SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Applicants must complete an [online application form](#), and upload the required supplementary documentation.

A completed application must contain:

- Application Form (content described above)
- Applicant's CV, including any applicable publications (e.g., abstracts, posters, manuscripts)
- Supervisor's CV (last 5 years, full)
- Official transcripts of all years of undergraduate study (including GPA)
- Letter of support from supervisor
- At least one professional/academic based reference letter (in addition to supervisor's letter)

Applications must be submitted electronically via the [online portal](#) no later than 11:59 pm in the applicant's time zone on Monday, January 31, 2022.

Applicants will receive notification of award no later than February 28, 2022.

An award will only be issued if an application of sufficient quality is received that fully meets the Studentship's eligibility requirements.
